

## Farm Update – Corn!

Hello Friends,

Do you love sweet corn? Do you rhapsodize on its golden loveliness and sweetness? What is your favorite way to enjoy corn.....especially fresh corn?

We have corn! Jonathan planted sweet corn and field corn in the winter paddock this year as a way to utilize the concentration of nutrients (i.e. manure) in this field with the hope of providing food for us and the chickens. Because our cows are grass fed, they will not be enjoying the corn but they love the husks, silks and stalks as a special treat. He even planted the rows a week apart so that the harvest would be spaced. However, the corn did not know it was supposed to come in slowly. Instead it is here – now.

So we are offering the “incredible” variety of sweet corn for \$4 for 1 dozen ears. This is a hybrid, non-GMO corn grown without pesticides that would be great for eating fresh or putting up for the coming months. We are freezing it in the husks, in whole kernels and also creamed for that wonderful Southern dish, fried corn.

We are also offering any of the grass finished beef in our freezer for 25% off so you can pick up ground beef for \$4.50/lb., roasts for \$5.25/lb. and soup bones for \$2.25/lb.

The corn will be played out by this weekend so just let us know if you would like to stop by to get some any afternoon after 4:00pm. We will be either in the corn patch or on the porch reveling in the goodness of the harvest.
